
# **Our Mission**

## Schedule an Appointment



#### Step 1

In a web browser, visit msstate.mywconline.com and create an account using your @msstate.edu email address.



#### Step 2

Log into your account and select the scheduler for the location you want to visit.



#### Step 3

Select the time you want to meet and complete the form to schedule your appointment.

After making your appointment, use the online scheduler at msstate.mywconline.com to:

- Log into your account and view availability
- Update your account
- Access your appointment details
- Edit or cancel an existing appointment
- Attend a scheduled virtual appointment
- View your client report form
- Create another appointment

On the day of your appointment, your client report will be emailed to you by midnight; for required appointments, this email will serve as a receipt that you can send to your professor.
